Introduction:

We face three great dangers in our discipleship to Jesus –

- Separating faith decisions from discipleship
- Localizing our discipleship to time, place, or event
- Forgetting how our discipleship to Jesus serves the continually growing nature of the Kingdom of God

Application & Conclusion:

We understand that God does a greater work of increasing transformation as we give him our consistent and continual "yes." We cannot limit God's calling to a time, location, or event. We believe the Kingdom comes when we follow Jesus in ordinary life and in an extraordinary mission. Brothers and sisters, friends, and strangers daily chasing after one Kingdom come – that's what makes our heartbeat.

Application & Conclusion:

We carry the love and good news of Jesus by serving others. We make significant impact through small, everyday helps. We hold no discrimination as we serve even the least of these (Matthew 25:31-46). We believe that we can change our church and our community when we serve, for the glory of God and the joy of those around us.
